

Sådan laver du en "Splash-Screen"

En såkaldt "Splash-screen" er en af de vigtigste elementer i din app. Det er den screen som bliver loadet omgående når brugeren trykker på dit icon og som viser brugeren at appen altså er startet - og der absolut ikke er nogen grund til at blive ved med at trykke på iconet.

Du starter med at gå ind i din apps "Control Panel"

Screen Nickname

This loads a full-size view with a background image that introduces the application
 You may or may not want to animate the view automatically but instead keep it in view until the user taps it. Note: splash screens are a special kind of plugin because they are used in the Global Theme.
 There are two steps to making a splash screen. 1) Create the screen in the apps list of screens. 2) Visit the apps Global Theme then set the splash screen to the one you created in the list.

Image File Names or Image URL (web address)?

Use an Image File Name or an Image URL - NOT BOTH. If you choose to use an Image File Name (and not a URL), you'll need to add the image to the Xcode or Eclipse project after you download the code for your app. The Image File Name value you enter in the control panel must match the file name of the image in your project. Example: mybackground.png. Do not use image file names that contain spaces or special characters.

If you use a URL (and not an Image File Name), the image will be downloaded from the URL then stored on the device for offline use. The Image URL should end with the name of the image file itself. Example: www.mysite.com/images/mybackground.png. You'll need to figure out whether or not it's best to include them in the project or use URL's, both approaches make sense, depending on your design goals.
